PARKING: We will be expanding our parking lot to the north, and adding new disabled spots, to ease crowding on busy days. Please remember to always be facing (or backed up to) a fence or rope, never beside one. Please remember to keep all emergency entrances and driveways clear and to **respect all disabled parking spots**. This means not stopping even for a minute to drop off or pick up. Please go park and then meet your kids.

Please always Enter the parking lot at the north end and Exit at the south end. Our goal is to keep cars and kids off the road. Please note that there is **NO PARKING** on much of the east side of Old Simcoe.

Dear Parents: If your child has any existing medical conditions, is on medication, or has suffered any kind of injury that could affect their ability to play soccer, please inform your coach and club before playing or practicing. Coaches need to be aware of these conditions for everyone's safety. Please use common sense before letting your child play. Safety is our 1st priority.

Children with casts or braces can play but these must be well padded and inspected by the referee before each game starts. Each Referee has the final decision on whether the player plays or not.

Please also be aware that players **may not wear jewelry of any kind**. This includes, earrings (and studs), necklaces, rings, watches, bracelets (medic alerts should be clear tapped). Remember the Referee doesn't make these OSA rules but must enforce them for everyone's safety.

Note: Your child's Coach is not a babysitter. A parent or guardian must always be present while kids are at the fields.
