

Scugog Soccer Association - Select/Rep Fees Explained – April 10, 2010

The Scugog Soccer Association is pleased to be able to field two Rep teams in the CESL for 2010. This would not be possible without the dedication of each team's coaching staff, which has been working on training and team plans, with the Scugog Soccer Board and our administrator for many months.

Scugog is a very small club when it comes to competing in the Rep leagues and so our teams have a tough time winning against some of the much larger south Durham clubs, but winning is not our only goal. We are here to help develop your child's soccer and life skills. Please keep our club's goal, "**The Fun Pursuit of Excellence**" in the back of your mind throughout the season and remind each other once in a while.

Please also remember that we're all here for the kid's sake. Make it fun, keep it safe. You as parents play a huge role in our Select/Rep program. You need to be positive role models for all of our players. Please keep your enthusiasm positive at all times towards referees, players, coaches and other parents, and remember our code of conduct which you have all agreed to by signing your child's registration form. Nothing makes me prouder than to hear an opposing coach tell us our team was a pleasure to play. Have your child wear his/her Laker uniform with pride as they represent not only their team and coaches, but also you as parents, their soccer club, even their home town.

The reason for this letter is to explain the costs of our Select/Rep program and how we come to the figure we need to charge you. Please be aware that we **do not** require our Select/Rep teams to do any additional fundraising, and in fact we have strict rules around fundraising activities due to Insurance reasons (i.e. they are likely not covered). Additional fees may be required for additional tournaments, team purchased equipment or excessive fines, not already known at this time. We are a non-profit club and strive to keep costs as low as possible in both house league and Rep programs.

All Select/Rep Players must first register for SSA House League prior to the final tryout session. The cost for this is \$145 if paid by March 7th, \$170 if paid later than March 7th.

There is no fee for Call Up players because as we see it, they are doing the team a favour. They may purchase the Warm Up clothing if they wish.

For retuning Rep players, you may reuse your old Laker warm up suit and bag if they are in good repair; or, order a new warm-up suit (or just the jacket or just the pants), or a new player bag, or any combination. Your costs are our costs. We make no profit on these fees. Players still get a photo, a ball and a Scugog T-Shirt. Please also realize that players are also getting hours and hours of certified soccer coaching at no additional cost. The team gets free use of the club pop-up tents at tournaments.
